Scope of Works:

Following controversial comments labelled at Paternoster Square by HRH Prince of Wales in 1998, the re-development of the site was specifically designed to reflect its esteemed surroundings under the shadow of St Paul's Cathedral.

Large niche to walkway from Paternoster Square to St Pauls Cathedral rebated rusticated ashlar to ground floor shops and offices featuring chamfered keystone heads. Amongst the usual sourcing, fabrication and installation of the masonry dressings, our ongoing investment in the most up to date technology and machinery proved crucial to the successful delivery of the project.
